Last call for Shoe Box Appeal 2021


Shoebboxes can be brought to St Andrew's church on Sunday 24 October.

The War Memorial was erected by the people of West Linton it was unveiled on the 24th of October 1921.

"The war memorial, which consists of a red freestone monument with bronze tablet, and on which is inscribed 32 names, is situated on the common between the Parish Church and the old toll-house. Sir James Ferguson, Bart. of Spital Haugh, who was convenor of committee introduced Sir Donald MacLean, M.P., who after addressing those present unveiled the monument.

NOTICE OF INDUCTION – Section 31(1) and section 32(1)

Notice is hereby given that the Presbytery of Melrose and Peebles has received a Call from this congregation of West Linton, St Andrew's and Broughton Glenholm and Kilbucho, Carlops, Kirkurd and Newlands, Skirling and Tweedsmuir addressed to Rev Dr Tony Foley to be the new minister. This Call has been sustained as a regular Call, and has been accepted by him.

The Presbytery, having judged the said Rev Dr Tony Foley qualified for this charge, has resolved to proceed to his induction on Monday the 25th day of October 2021 at 7 o'clock. The only circumstance in which this would not occur is if an objection occurs which may reasonably impede it.

Notice is given that if any member of this congregation of West Linton, St Andrew's and Broughton Glenholm and Kilbucho, Carlops, Kirkurd and Newlands, Skirling and Tweedsmuir, has objection to the life or doctrine of the said Rev Dr Tony Foley, you should intimate your objection at the earliest opportunity to the Presbytery Clerk. If you do this, you will also need to submit to the Presbytery Clerk appropriate evidence to substantiate your objection.

The Presbytery is to meet at 6.45pm on Monday 25th October 2021. If an objection is not notified in advance but is first brought at that meeting the objector must satisfy the Presbytery that there was no earlier opportunity to bring the objection to the attention of the Presbytery Clerk.

Unless a substantiated objection is made which is then upheld, the Presbytery shall proceed to induction of the said Rev Dr Tony Foley without further delay.

Induction Service at St Andrew's - Monday 25th October 2021 – 7:00pm

The induction service for Rev Dr Tony Foley is confirmed for 7pm on 25th October at St Andrew's Church. The service will be conducted by the current Moderator of Presbytery, Rev Victoria Linford. As is customary, the preacher will be the minister who is the most recently appointed in Presbytery, Rev Fraser Edwards, minister of Innerleithen, Traquair and Walkerburn. Those registering are asked to provide a contact number to save time collecting this on arrival at Church. Those planning to come are reminded to use the hand gel provided on arrival and are asked to remember that masks will be required throughout the service, also to aim to be seated by 6:50pm. This service will be video recorded, so our members and others can watch the service via the link we will later provide on our Parish websites.
